

Guidelines for granting money from the IAHR/CIPSH funds

IAHR/CIPSH grants will normally be made available to scholars and to postgraduate students under the following conditions:

- a) The applicant must be a paid up member of a national or regional association which is a member to the IAHR. Alternatively the applicant must be an individual member of the IAHR.
- b) The applicant must show evidence of having sought funding from other available institutions or associations, such as the applicant's home university or national funding organisations.
- c) The applicant must present a paper at the conference, alternatively organize or chair a panel, function as respondent, or the like.
- d) The applicant must present an abbreviated CV.
- e) The applicant, if a student, must present a letter of recommendation either from an official within the relevant national association or from a senior scholar.
- f) Preference will be given to those officers or members who have been delegated by their national or regional association to be one of two representatives (normally the President and the Secretary) to the International Committee of the IAHR. *Only delegates from member associations that are paid up will be considered eligible for receiving funding.*

Grants normally are partial and intended to cover travel costs.
